## 1 Terre Forti Sangiovese Rubicone - Italy

A textbook red from the country that brought us parmesan, olive oil, pasta and mozzarella. Juicy cherry fruit, subtle spice and a food-friendly style.

## 2 Chilensis Merlot - Chile
